Andrés TANGUITO Cejas is a choreographer, dancer and represents the purest style of Argentine Tango. A much loved and respected figure in Buenos Aires and worldwide, Director of the most popular Practica in Buenos Aires "De Querusa". For the last 4 years he has been member of the Grand Jury of the Tango Mundial BA , was awarded by the "Argentine Council of Dance" with the prestigious "Maria Ruanova" diploma honoris causa as master of Tango, for his contribution to teaching Tango at National and International levels. He performed with many renowned orchestras, amongst which Sexteto Mayor and the one of the Master Mariano Mores, with whom performed at London's Royal Festival Hall. His work extends for over 28 years, focused to maintain the authentic Tango de Salón style of his home city. His Tango upholds the purest form of social dance, the classic lineage of Villa Urquiza style, absorbed at source from the great milongueros, like Portalea, Petaca, El Chino Perico. The legendary Osvaldo Zotto, of whom Tanguito is the first and only follower, was a key component in the development and maturation of his Tango. Those legendary dancers are the makers of the Tango we know today and Genoveva Tanguito's teaching, and dancing is an exquisite combination of all these influences. Classes are taught in fluent English and are suitable for intermediate to advanced levels.
